



Transportation Supervisor

Our goal at Family Tapestry is to ensure each child is safe in care, achieves permanency, improves their overall wellbeing, experiences fewer moves and shorter stays in care, and increases family engagement, which leads to better outcomes, trusting relationships, and meaningful connections. The Transportation Supervisor will provide scheduling, coordination and supervision to the Transportation Specialist team. Will work collaboratively with other Family Tapestry Supervisors to ensure client and family transportation needs are met.

.Responsibilities Include:

- Oversees and schedules the transportation specialists for assignments based on client and family needs through coordination with intake supervisor and case management supervisors
- Develop an on-call rotation schedule for transportation specialists to ensure transportation will be available as needed 24/7/365
- Ensure oversight of Family Tapestry fleet of vehicles, ensuring proper maintenance and logs are kept
- Coordinate transportation to and from for large events such as the regional statewide conferences such as the Texas Teens Conference
- Responsible for interviewing, hiring and training employees; planning, assigning and directing work; evaluating performance; coaching and developing staff.
- Supports the strengthening and management of the culture and practices that reflects the organization's mission and core values and fosters high engagement in staff.
- Builds and maintains strong, collaborative relationships with DFPS, the provider network and children and youth.
- On call availability as needed

Requirements:

- Minimum of three years of supervisory experience
- Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university in social work or related field preferred
- Previous work in the foster care system or understanding of the Texas DFPS system is preferred.
- Bilingual with English and Spanish is a plus
